The 2012 Woodcarving Show was held March 17 & 18 and had a good turnout of carvings entered in the competition. There were seventy carvers that entered 158 carvings (Both numbers approximately the same as last year). The judges were Gerald Grusendorf, Tom Grile, and John Barany. They awarded 47 Blue (1st), 34 Red (2nd), 25 Yellow (3rd), and 25 White (Honorable Mention) Ribbons/Pins.

From the 1st place category carvings the 3rd Best of Show was a Western Mountain Bluebird by Bernie Wozniak, the 2nd Best of Show was a card playing caricature by John Karalunas, and the 1st Best of Show was a brown trout by Ron Copes.

As you know the soap carving kits were supplied free by the Michigan Wood Carvers Association.
